Ports in Haiti Closed Following Assassination of President

Following the assassination of President Jovenel Moïse on 7 July 2021, all port operations in Haiti have stopped.

Local correspondents E&M Multiprime advise that the country is effectively closed. There are no operations at the ports, the airports are closed, and the people are remaining at home.

The Port Authority has not issued any official communication, but it is reported that vessels are being ordered to leave without a pilot on board, as pilots are unable to reach the ports.
