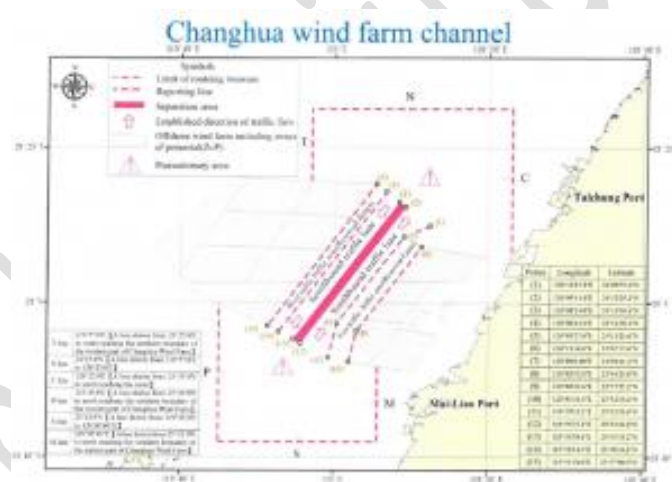
New Pre-arrival Reporting Requirements in Taiwan for Changhua

Wind Farm Channel

New rules in Taiwan will require vessels intending to pass through the Changhua Wind Farm Channel to notify the Marine Port Bureau in advance.

The new notification requirements will take effect on 26 October 2021, where all vessels (except Taiwan military and Taiwanese fishing vessels) must declare to the Marine Port Bureau eight hours in advance of entering the channel.

The Changhua Wind Farm is located between Taichung Port and Mai-Liao Port as shown in the below diagram kindly provided by Taiwan Maritime Services Limited.



A failure to provide a pre-arrival notification could result in a fine of NTD500,000 (approximately US\$18,000).
