Distribution Of Major Fishery Farms Near Rizhao/Lanshan Port

And Dalian Port

China MSA issues update on distribution of major fishery farms near Rizhao/Lanshan Port and Dalian Port.

Ships run the risk of accidentally damaging newly expanded fishery farms.

Club correspondent Huatai Marine has issued its circular [PNI \[2023\] 09](#) which outlines the distribution of major fishery farms along the coast of China, near Rizhao/Lanshan Port and Dalian Port.

Rizhao/Lanshan Port

There are a large number of navigation obstruction nets in the waters east of Rizhao Port, and the specific geographical coordinates of the navigation obstruction nets are published in the attached pdfs.

Dalian Port

The scope of the fishery farms in Dalian port, waters mentioned in Circular PNI [2023] 04 has been expanded to the west and the south. The data available so far indicate that the western boundary of the newly opened fishery farm is quite close to the eastern boundary of the tanker and cargo ship anchorage, therefore, there is a significant risk of accidentally entering the fishery farms for ships intending to proceed to the anchorage from the waters east of the anchorage.
