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Israel adopts new sewage regulations

Israel adopts national regulations for sewage pollution prevention, reflecting IMO MARPOL ANNEX IV regulations, which will come into force from 27 June 2024.

Club correspondent Harpaz P&I provides an update on Israel's new sewage regulations.

As most international shipping already complies with annex IV regulations there is no significant implications for ships calling Israeli ports following the adoption of these regulation in Israel **except** the fact that from 27 June 2024 all Israeli's ports & terminals must provide shore reception facilities for sewage, if required by ships, upon early notice 24 hours before the vessel arrival to Israeli port (as per the attach format). Further to the requirements of annex IV, the discharge of treated sewage into the sea in Israeli's ports limits is not allowed.
